This \$200 Million program includes entry gates at over 48 military installations located throughout the continental United States (CONUS). This program is a part of the Army Chief of Staff's initiative which began in October 2002 to strengthen installation security by providing cost-effective, state-of-the-art and logistically supportable physical security and force protection systems to installations and forces deployed worldwide

The US Army Corps of Engineers, Engineering and Support Center, Huntsville was selected by the Product Manager for Force Protection Systems (PM-FPS) to plan, manage and execute its Access Control Point Equipment Program (ACPEP) and the Automated Installation Entry (AIE) Program. As a result of the mandate that Army installations transition to "closed" posts, the Corps of Engineers asked us to assist in development of the Phase II world-wide program to survey, assess, design, purchase and install components of equipment that enhanced the protection posture of every gate at every Army installation. To support this program we have assisted in development of Statements of Work, Blanket Purchase Agreements, managing the information database, conducting surveys, training field engineers on the standards, and providing on-site assistance. This effort has given us a unique advantage by completely understanding the standards and requirements of DoD entry control. Additionally we are completely versed in all components of control including fixed and portable barrier systems, lighting, vehicle inspections (manual and automated), x-ray machines, CCTV interface, duress systems, guard and visitor facilities, intrusion detection systems, perimeter monitoring, and tying all to a central monitoring center.



Combs & Shearer continues to provide technical expertise to the Engineering and Support Center, Huntsville ACPEP program, by reviewing contractor submittals, reviewing shop drawings, conducting construction inspections and assisting in the Performance Verification Tests (PVT) as well as for the AIE program. The purpose of the AIE program is to upgrade access control points (gates) by adding an automated entry system. This system will reduce guard force requirements and costs associated with vehicle and personnel access to installations, enhance security through validation of personal credentials prior to entrance and maximize vehicle through-put rate at gate entrances.
